

**Title Luke 10 T Building Relationships & Meeting Needs**

**Welcome**

Host to welcome people, especially new members.

**Worship**

Lead a time of worship. Ps 118v1-9 may be helpful. Ask people to give thanks for anything they have received from or experienced of God over the past week. If you have musical gifts singing could be an option.

**Word**

Read Luke 10v1-9 v16-17

1. What does Jesus tell his disciples to do upon entering a town or village before preaching and healing? Why do you think he does this?
2. What's the difference between broadcasting the Gospel and communicating the Gospel?
3. Can there be such a thing as bad evangelism?

Read Luke 19v1-8

4. What led Zacchaeus to repentance?
5. In what ways can we build relationships of trust and friendship with others? (Be practical )
6. How do we feel about doing this? What barriers do we have to overcome? What if we are shy?

Read 1 Pt 2 v11-12, 1 Pt 3v1-2 Mt 5v13-16

7. What kind of witness do you think your lifestyle is to Jesus? What areas do you need to work on?
8. What did Jesus instruct the disciples to do to help the people in the places they visited?
9. The Luke 10-T approach interprets this by saying that we should follow this example by *meeting peoples' needs*. Is this valid?

Read Luke 10v27.

10. How does this and the following parable support the *meeting needs* interpretation.
11. Most people we know are materially provided for. What kind of needs do they have that we might meet?
12. How do you feel about offering to pray for the people you meet? How can you follow the leading of the Holy Spirit in this?
13. Is Jesus power to heal and deliver available to us today and how can it be released?

Share any experiences you may have had of healing or being healed.
